



Guidelines for POSTER PRESENTATION

All abstracts/case reports accepted for **oral presentation** at the **international LVV-PMR conference** have to be presented in person in Innsbruck, Austria. The presenting author requires to register as a participant (if not a faculty member).

- Presentation date and time: **October 2, 2024, Lunch Time**
- **Time allocated** to your E-poster presentation: **5 minutes: 4' E-poster presentation (PDF) + 1' Live Q&A**

Authors are required to prepare a **PDF version of their poster** and to send it via e-mail to events@pdl.at not later than **September 15, 2024, 23:59 CEST**.

Please note that we do not require any printed version of your poster nor any audio pre-recording. With the submission you agreed that your abstract/case report will be presented in its accepted form at the conference; it is not possible anymore to make changes to the content.

ABSTRACT PUBLICATION

Accepted scientific abstracts will be published in an electronic abstract supplement of the **Clinical and Experimental Rheumatology**. Abstracts will also be available on the conference webpage from **October 1, 2024** onwards for a maximum of 6 months after the conference.

AWARDS

Among accepted and on-side presented abstracts / case reports, **3 abstract awards and 1 case report award** will be nominated. This will be based on the scientific content and quality of presentation.

POSTER FORMAT

All posters **will be presented as a digital version on dedicated screens**. We do not need a printed version of the poster.

- Size (In cm) **60 cm width x 97.2 cm height**. IMPORTANT: Please use **Portrait mode**
- Font size: needs to be at least 16 pt. Please ensure that all figures and images are implemented in the highest resolution so that they can be zoomed in on the screen.
- Authors are allowed to incorporate QR codes on their posters for the purpose of disseminating the content. The information available using the QR code should be freely accessible and should not require any log-in.
- No specific Poster template is recommended and there is no word count limit. Font size needs to be at least 16 pt to ensure that all text can be read during the presentation.
- Please include the following information in your presentation:
 - Title, author names and affiliations, working groups
 - Abstract number
 - Background
 - Objectives
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
 - References (optional)
 - Conflict of interest statement
 - Tables and Figures including respective legends. There is no limit for the number of tables and figures
- Agents/molecules must follow the scientific standard for publications.
